### SCHEDULE

Wednesdays - **TWO** bags every week.

Boxing Day - Wednesday, December 26th, 2012 collection moves **AHEAD** to Friday, December 28th, 2012.

The Arnprior Waste Disposal Site is open Monday, Wednesday, Friday - 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. and Saturday - 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. and will be **CLOSED** on most holidays.

**ADDITIONAL** 'bag tags' for use to dispose of extra garbage may be purchased at the Town Hall, the Library, or the Nick Smith Centre.

**TIME & PLACEMENT:** Garbage **MUST** be placed at the curbside by **7:30 a.m.** on the day of collection. During winter months, please **DO NOT** place garbage bags/containers behind, on top, or in the side of snow banks.

**SIZE, WEIGHT, & LIMIT:** Please see the reverse side for details.

**LEAF & YARD WASTE:** Plants, flowers, weeds, leaves, grass clippings, trimmed branches (less than 1.5 inches diameter). Residents are encouraged to compost Leaf & Yard Waste. Leaf & Yard Waste **MUST** be packaged in biodegradable **PAPER** bags and placed at the curbside by **7:30 a.m.** on the day of collection. Leaf & Yard Waste may be disposed of at the Arnprior Waste Disposal Site, during hours of operation for **FREE**.

Christmas trees may be disposed of at the Arnprior Waste Disposal Site, during hours of operation until January 31, 2012 for **FREE**. Please **DO NOT** dispose of Christmas trees at the curbside.

Spring Leaf & Yard Waste Collection Day: **Wednesday, May 23rd, 2012**

Fall Leaf & Yard Waste Collection Day: **Wednesday, November 14th, 2012**

**BRUSH:** Shrubs, hedges, trees, large branches (larger than 1.5 inches in diameter), stumps, logs, timber. Brush is **NOT** considered Leaf & Yard Waste and will **NOT** be picked-up at the curbside. Brush **MUST** be disposed of at the Arnprior Waste Disposal Site and tipping fees apply.

**COMPOSTING:** Compost to reduce your household waste, save money on garbage/Leaf & Yard Waste bags, and soil costs in the Spring. The Town of Arnprior has composters available for purchase at Town Hall.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW):** Paints, solvents, automotive products (waste oil, waste coolant, oil filters), herbicides, pesticides, batteries, propane tanks. The HHW depot is a summer program that typically runs from May - August and is held at the Renfrew Waste Disposal Site, located at 376 Bruce Street, Renfrew, ON. Other local options for disposal of HHW materials exist in Arnprior. **Please see the reverse side for details.**

**RESTRICTIONS:** Large items (stoves, refrigerators, furniture, mattresses, hot water tanks, automotive parts, scrap metal) will **NOT** be collected from the curbside. These items may be disposed of at the Arnprior Waste Disposal Site. Tipping fees apply. Garbage will **NOT** be collected if it contains large quantities of dog or cat feces, items not properly contained, loose ashes and/or sawdust, HHW, is overweight, oversized, over the limit, or contains Leaf & Yard Waste.

# TOWN OF ARNPRIOR – Garbage Collection Information

## Bags, Containers, Sizes, Weights, & Limits:

**WEDNESDAYS – TWO (2) BAGS EVERY WEEK**

The **maximum** weight for each **BAG** or **CONTAINER** is **50 lbs (22.7 kg)**.

**ALL OVERWEIGHT BAGS/CONTAINERS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED**

The **maximum** sized **BAG** – approximately 26" x 32" and **CONTAINER** – approximately 67 L.

**ALL OVERSIZED BAGS/CONTAINERS MUST BE TAGGED**

#### Household Hazardous Waste Disposal

Household hazardous wastes (HHW) are harmful to humans and the environment. HHW **MUST** be disposed of in a responsible, controlled manner. Please do **NOT** dispose of HHW in your regular garbage.



If you didn't get a chance to drop off your household hazardous wastes (HHW) at the Renfrew Waste Disposal Site this summer, please see below for local businesses in Arnprior that accept various HHW all year!

#### BUSINESSES

**Rona Home Centre:** any brand of latex, oil (alkyd), enamel or other paints, metal or anti-rust paints, aluminum paint, stains, varnish, urethane, spray paint cans, wood preservative, masonry paint.

**Note:** Paint products must be in original container

**Canadian Tire:** waste oil, oil filters, antifreeze, empty oil containers, antifreeze containers, car batteries, rechargeable batteries.

**Shopper's Drug Mart:** pharmaceuticals & syringes

**Rexall Pharmacy:** pharmaceuticals & syringes

**Clancy's Drug Store:** pharmaceuticals

**NOTE:** Syringes brought back to these locations **MUST** be stored in approved biohazardous containers. The containers will not be returned.

#### TOWN PROGRAMS

**Town Hall, Library, Nick Smith Centre:** rechargeable batteries weighing less than 11 lbs/5 kg; cell phones.

The Arnprior Waste Disposal Site is **CLOSED** on Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday, & Holidays.

**Location:** 658 River Road, McNab/Braeside, ON

#### Information

- The Arnprior Waste Disposal Site is only open to Arnprior and McNab/Braeside residents.
- Arnprior Waste Disposal Site vouchers **MUST** be purchased at the Town Hall or the Nick Smith Centre prior to entry into the Arnprior Waste Disposal Site.
- Tipping fees apply for the use of the Arnprior Waste Disposal Site and are based on vehicle size. The tipping fee schedule may be found at [www.arnprior.ca](http://www.arnprior.ca).
- One (1) **FREE** Arnprior Waste Disposal Site voucher is available per Arnprior residential unit per year. **ONLY** the owner of the property can claim this voucher.
- Illegal dumping is strictly prohibited. **NO** items shall be left at the Arnprior Waste Disposal Site gate, as that is considered illegal dumping.
