Notice of Metric Water and Wastewater Rates
Effective January 1, 2010
August, 2010

The following 2010 rates are calculated using the 2010 rates passed by Council on December 21, 2009 converted to rates per cubic metre. Starting with this billing all bills will now be calculated using the metric rates as all new water meters are recording consumption in cubic metres.

Commodity Charges

(These are charges based on the following water and wastewater rates multiplied by water consumption)

one cubic metre equals 220 gallons

(i)	For the first 455 cubic metres per month	\$1.27 per cubic metre	\$1.25 per cubic metre	\$2.52 per cubic metre
(ii)	For any excess over 455 cubic metres per month	\$0.76 per cubic metre	\$0.75 per cubic metre	\$1.51 per cubic metre

Base Rate Charges

(These are fixed monthly charges for water and wastewater services regardless of consumption but based on the size of your water meter)

Outside water Users

The rates and charges for water and wastewater services outside the limits of the Town of Arnprior shall be 1 1/2 times the commodity rates and shall be the regular base rate charges charged to users of the Town of Arnprior.
