New Animal Control By-law

Do you own a dog or cat or plan to get one?
Then, please note the following changes:

Things to Know Now...

- Only 2 dogs and 2 cats are permitted per household
- **However, there is a grandfathering clause:** One additional dog and one additional cat (which were owned prior to July 11, 2011) is allowed per household (for up to a total of 3 dogs and/or 3 cats) **provided the animal has been registered.**

Note: A grandfathered dog or cat cannot be replaced in the future.



Coming This Fall/Winter 2011 ...

Fines (tickets) will be pursuant to Part I of the *Provincial Offenses Act*

How does this affect you?

If you receive a ticket for violation of the Animal Control By-law which is required to be paid, the outstanding amount plus interest will be **registered against your driver's license or a vehicle permit renewal.**

Coming in January 2012 ...

- Cats are to be registered annually and subject to the same licensing fees as dogs.
- **A free registration period for January and February will be provided.** This is a new process which will be reviewed in the Fall of 2012 for effectiveness.
- Late payment fees for cats and dogs increase to \$30 if neutered/spayed and \$50 if not.
