



2022 Municipal Election Information for Voters

Municipal and School Board Elections occur every four years in Ontario and the legislation for the conduct of an election are set out in the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched.*, as amended.

Next Municipal Election – October 24, 2022

- The next regular Municipal Election to elect a Mayor, County Councillor, five (5) at-large Councillors, and School Board Trustees (English Public, English Separate, French Public, and French Separate) is on Monday, October 24, 2022.
- The Town of Arnprior uses internet and telephone voting for its municipal and school board elections. More information on how to vote and the list of Certified Candidates is included on the back of this information sheet.

Municipal Voter's List

- You need to be on the voter's list to vote in a municipal and school board election.
- All registered voters will receive a Voter Information Letter (VIL) by mail in the beginning of October 2022. This Voter Information Letter will include your Personal Identification Number (PIN) which you will need to vote.
- If you do not receive a VIL, you will need to be added to the Voter's List. Revisions can be made by submitting a written application form to the Town Clerk, in person at the Voter Help Centre.

Voting in the municipal and school board election is easy and convenient. You can vote 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, anywhere, anytime with an internet / telephone connection.

- ✓ Receive Voter Information Letter (VIL) and confirm that your information is correct.

Voting Online

1	Access the voting website using the URL listed on your Voter Information Letter.
2	When prompted, enter your Personal Identification Number (PIN) and date of birth to validate access to your electronic ballot.
3	Follow instructions to select which candidates you wish to support and to review your selection.

Voting by Telephone

1	Call the toll-free phone number listed on your Voter Information Letter.
2	When prompted, enter your Personal Identification Number (PIN) and date of birth to validate access to your electronic ballot.
3	Follow instructions to select which candidates you wish to support and to review your selection.
