# Arnprior Skateboard Park Sponsorship Opportunities







# About the project...

A skate park was first established in the Town of Arnprior in 2002 following continued engagement from the local skateboarding community. Ten years later (2012), the park was upgraded to the modular skate park that exists today.

In June 2023, the Arnprior Skateboard Association (ASA) presented a delegation to Council to present the merits of skateboarding as a sport and youth engagement vehicle as well as request commitment to fund a new and improved skatepark. Council approved \$25,000 for the design of a new/revitalized skatepark in 2024 with construction to occur in 2026 with a budget of \$250,000.

The Recreation and Parks Master Plan has identified that the current skatepark location is not ideal and the nearby vacant parkland adjacent to the entrance of the Nick Smith Centre would be an optimal location that Council has now approved. This parkland is conveniently close to the Nick Smith Centre amenities including washrooms, water fountains and parking.

Discussions with users and industry professionals have indicated that skateboarders tend to prefer concrete features rather than modular features largely due to smoother transitions and more interesting shapes. Staff have and will continue to consult with ASA on the park's design and features.

The Arnprior Skateboard Association (ASA) has demonstrated a significantly sized user base of skateboard enthusiasts and learners that participate in the ASA's various programming organized over the past several years.

The Town of Arnprior has committed a budget of \$275,000 towards this project (design + build) with additional support towards this project coming from the the Arnprior Skateboard Association, sponsorship and grants.
