BY-LAW NO. 6149-12 re Amendment to Animal Control By-law No. 5991-11



BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND ANIMAL CONTROL BY-LAW NO. 5991-11 BY REPLACING SCHEDULE A WITH A NEW SCHEDULE, DENOTING CHANGES IN THE PET REGISTRATION SYSTEM AND FEES.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior approved a staff report on October 9, 2012, to amend the Animal Control By-law No. 5991-11 with regard to the pet registration system and fees as indicated in a new Schedule A.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ARNPRIOR ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 6149-12 be enacted to amend Animal Control By-law No. 5991-11 by replacing Schedule A with a new schedule, denoting changes in the pet registration system and fees as attached.
2. The by-law shall come into full force and take effect on the passing thereof.

**SCHEDULE "A" to Animal Control By-law No. 5991-11**  
**Re: License Fees**  
***(to take effect January 1, 2013)***

- a) **Registration for each dog or cat:**  
From January 1<sup>st</sup> to February 28<sup>th</sup> (or 29<sup>th</sup>) of each year FREE  
For dogs or cats adopted from the Arnprior Humane Society FREE
- b) **License Fee for each dog or cat:**  
From March 1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> of each year and spayed or neutered: \$ 25.00  
From March 1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> of each year and not spayed or neutered: \$ 50.00  
  
After March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year and spayed or neutered: \$ 50.00  
After March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year and not spayed or neutered: \$100.00
- c) **Release Fee:**  
As determined by Animal Shelter
- d) **Replacement Tag:** \$ 5.00
- e) **Exceptions to the registration fee:**  
As determined by the By-law Enforcement Officer or the Clerk pursuant to the enforcement protocols.
