Leaf and Yard Waste must be placed at the curbside by 7:30 AM on November 8th, 2023

Garbage and recycling containers must be placed at the curbside by 7:30 AM (9:30 AM if located Downtown). **The contractor will not return for late set-outs.**

# Arnprior 2023 Waste Management Guide

## How to Sort Your Recycle Box

### Week 1 - Plastic, Glass & Metal Containers



### Week 2 - Paper & Cardboard



### Not Recyclable



All recyclables **must be loose** in your blue box. Do not place recyclables in plastic bags as they will **not** be collected.

## Garbage Collection Requirements

- Maximum of two (2) 65L garbage bags per week, extra bags must be tagged.
- Extra bag tags can be purchased at Town Hall for \$3.00 each.
- The weight of the garbage can and its contents must not exceed 50 lbs. Overweight Bags / Containers will **not** be collected.
- Maximum sized container approximately 67 L.
- Oversized containers count as additional bags.
- Garbage bags that appear to be mixed with recyclable materials or leaf and yard waste will **not** be collected.
- Bulky Items (couches, broken appliances) are not collected curbside and must be taken to the landfill located at 658 River Road, McNab/Braeside. Tipping Fees May Apply.
