Revitalized Arenas at the Nick Smith Centre!

The Town of Arnprior is undergoing an arena revitalization project to replace failing infrastructure, improve accessibility, and create new meeting and storage spaces. With the arenas reaching the half century mark, a series of issues over the past several years have impacted ice availability and increased maintenance costs signaling the need for replacement. This project is essential to continue to offer ice surfaces and meet the growing needs of our community. The total budget for the construction scope is \$7.1 Million.

The project kicked off on February 17th, 2025 with the closure of the Glenn Arthur arena. The Bert Hall arena closes on March 17th, 2025, and both arenas are scheduled to reopen in Fall 2025.
